Fond du Lac Comfort Food: A&W's Chicken Worth the Detour

In a city full of classic Wisconsin drive-ins and family diners, A&W Restaurant on Winnebago Drive holds a special kind of nostalgia. You don't just stop here to eat — you stop to slow down. The smell of fry oil, the sound of the drive-thru speaker crackling to life, and that unmistakable sweetness of fresh root beer in a frosty mug all signal the same thing: uncomplicated comfort food done right. While A&W is famous for its burgers and floats, locals know there's another menu category quietly carrying the experience — the chicken.

The Chicken That Keeps Regulars Coming Back

A&W's chicken isn't positioned as trendy Nashville-hot or artisan-buttermilk gourmet. It succeeds for the opposite reason: consistency and texture engineering. The kitchen uses hand-breaded preparation, which produces a crust that fractures rather than flakes — a key difference. Instead of shattering crumbs everywhere, the coating adheres tightly to the meat, so each bite delivers crunch and moisture simultaneously.

What stands out immediately:

- Audible crisp exterior
- Juicy interior (not steam-soft)
- Pepper-forward seasoning instead of heavy salt
- Balanced fry oil flavor — present, not greasy

The tenders, especially, hit a sweet spot between fast-food convenience and supper-club familiarity. They taste closer to bar-basket chicken than freezer-to-fryer product — which explains why families order them as meals, not just sides for kids.

Why It Works in Wisconsin

Fond du Lac diners have high standards for fried foods — Friday fish fries and tavern baskets set the baseline. Personally, I am VERY picky when it comes to chicken and fish. A&W's chicken fits that regional palate: hearty, straightforward, and filling rather than novelty-driven. Pair it with fries and a mug of root beer and you get a meal that feels halfway between a drive-thru stop and a casual local hangout.

That's the brand's strength. Since 1919 the chain has leaned into simple Americana — burgers, floats, and hand-breaded chicken — rather than chasing trends, and the Fond du Lac location keeps that identity intact.

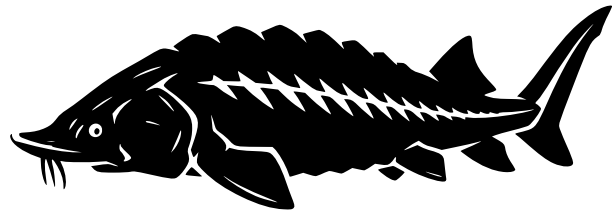

A Fond du Lac Winter Tradition Returns: Sturgeon Spectacular 2026

Every February, winter in Fond du Lac comes alive in the best possible way with the return of Sturgeon Spectacular, a signature downtown festival that celebrates everything we love about the season. Always held the second weekend of February, this year's event runs February 13-15, 2026, bringing locals and visitors together for a weekend packed with art, food, music, and community fun. It's one of those weekends where cold temps don't slow anyone down, they just give us another reason to gather.

One of the biggest highlights of Sturgeon Spectacular is the Wisconsin Snow Sculpting Championship, presented by Grande Cheese Company. Massive blocks of snow are transformed into detailed works of art right in the heart of downtown, drawing crowds all weekend long. Alongside the main competition, the High School Snow Sculpting Competition adds another layer of creativity and excitement, showing off the talent and imagination of local students.



Beyond the sculptures, Sturgeon Spectacular turns downtown Fond du Lac into a full winter playground. Visitors can enjoy ice carvings scattered throughout downtown, horse-drawn wagon rides, live music and entertainment at the Thelma Sadoff Center for the Arts, and a lineup of beloved events like the Chili Crawl, Sweet Stroll, Bloody Mary Contest, and outdoor floor curling at Fond du Lac Beer Company. Local businesses also join in with special promotions, making it a great weekend to shop, eat, and explore.

Whether you're coming for family-friendly activities, downtown vibes, sturgeon spearing season, or just an excuse to get out and enjoy winter together, Sturgeon Spectacular delivers. Made possible through the support of community partners like the Downtown Fond du Lac Partnership, Destination Lake Winnebago Region, and the City of Fond du Lac, this one-of-a-kind festival continues to be a reminder of how special winter can be when a community comes together.

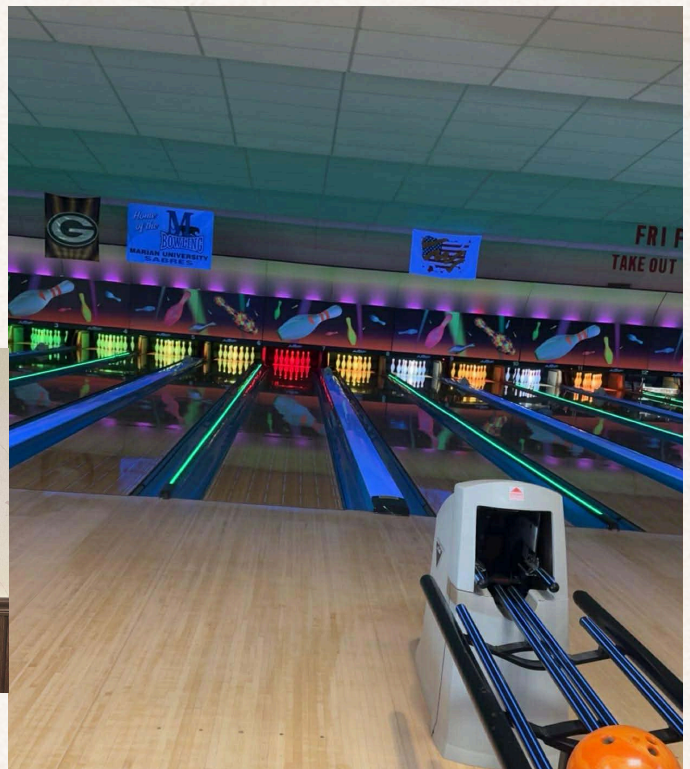
Fond du Lac Hosts One of the Largest Bowling Tournaments in the U.S.

Looking for something to do next week? Be sure to checkout Fishing Has No Boundaries (FHNB) Annual Bash at Sunset on the Water Friday 2/13 through Saturday 2/14. Sunset on the Water is located at N7364 Winnebago Dr, Fond du Lac, WI 54935.

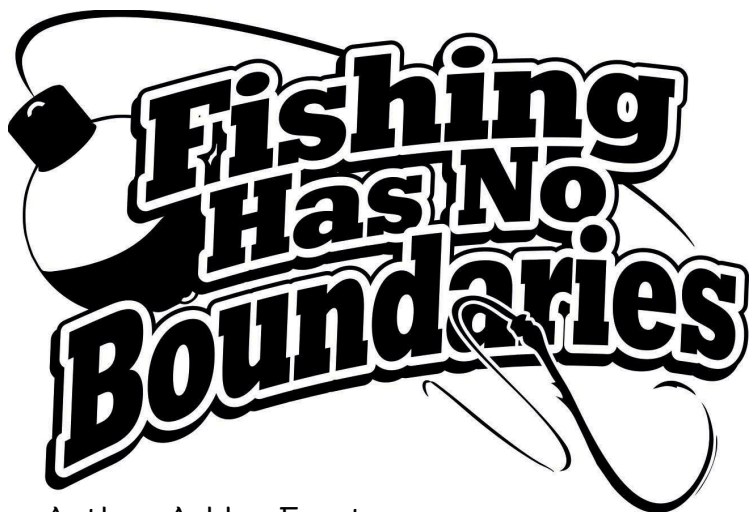
What's FHNB? It's a non-profit chapter of a statewide program that offers opportunities for all anglers with disabilities regardless of their sex, race, gender, or disability. They hold their annual event at Owen Island inside Lakeside Park in Fond du Lac.

This year, Cherry Pie will play on Friday night, and Driftwood will play on Saturday night. So get out those dancing shoes, and come support a great cause!

New this year, the Fond du Lac County Tavern League will be offering safe rides home for any of the patrons attending the FHNB event. If you're interested in taking advantage of this, stop at the hostess station inside Sunset to secure your ride with one of the volunteers.

Did you know, any Tavern League bar offers this for their patrons (if available) in order to eliminate the number of drunk drivings on Wisconsin's roadways. Rides can be requested by asking your bartender at any Tavern League location. Rides are completed through Uber, local cab companies, and good samaritans. Uber was recently added as a tool in order to increase the availability of safe rides. The only caveat is you have to be taken to your home, hotel, or residence. Safe ride does not take patrons to other bars, gas stations, etc.

So, if you end up having a few too many next weekend, be sure to stop in at the hostess stand inside Sunset to request your free ride home.

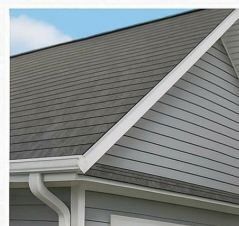
